NEW INFORMATION FOR 2015

-Please remember to crush down all cans and plastics. Air space takes up a lot of volume in the bins resulting in increased trucking costs.

-Dry cell battery recycling is available at all three waste sites and Township office as well as a number of local businesses.

-The Township office and three waste sites sell blue boxes to help with recycling (seven dollars per box).

-Some Businesses are selling Township garbage bags. Check the Township website for participating retailers.

-Stay tuned to the newspaper and Township website because there will continue to be changes in 2015 as the Township continues to increase diversion.

GARBAGE BAG REQUIREMENTS

All residents wishing to pay tipping fees may only do so at the Olden or Oso waste Disposal Site. Residents will no longer be able to prepay at the Township office. Contractors may purchase their tipping fee receipts at either the Township office or at the waste site. (Only cash or checks are accepted at the waste sites.)

- Clear Garbage bags:

- 30" x 38" - \$1.00 per bag
- 35" x 50" - \$2.00 per bag

Oversized bags, bundles or boxed material shall cost more

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Township holds a free Household Hazardous Waste Day once per year. The event for 2015 is scheduled for July 18th at the corner of Highway 7 and Road 38. The event will run from 9am-2pm. This event will be advertised in the local newspaper and signs will be placed at the location well in advance. Please take the following items to the household Hazardous waste day: Paint, empty or full oil containers, all light bulbs and light tubes, old gas and motor oil

Please note this is not a complete list but rather some of the materials that are prohibited in the garbage at the waste site.

1. White Goods –no charge
 - Washer, dryer, water tanks, gas tank, BBQ
 - Refrigerator, Freezer, Air ConditionersWe accept units with refrigerant gas still in the unit.

2. Tire Disposal is free (no rims and clean)

3. E-waste no charge

No charge for recycled items.

Clean wood products, brush for burning, Compostable Yard Waste including vegetation such as leaves, grass cuttings, plant stalks, and top soil. This compostable waste is only accepted at the Hinchinbrooke District Site (10180 Rd 38) at no charge and shall be placed on the burn pile with the plastic bags removed.

PROHIBITED WASTE MATERIALS FOR LANDFILLING

The following items shall be prohibited for disposal within the landfill area of the Municipal Waste Disposal Site:

- Hazardous waste - industrial waste - dead animals
- Car bodies - farm machinery
- Asphalt pavement - cement or brick blocks

WASTE SITE MATERIALS AND RECYCLING POLICY

1. Shingles are accepted only at Olden District waste site (1094 Olden Park Road), and Oso District waste site (1130 Wemp Road).

2. Clean lumber and brush is only accepted at the Hinchinbrooke Transfer Station (10180 Rd 38) at no charge.

Construction Debris & White Goods are only accepted at the Oso District & Olden District Waste Disposal Sites.

3. Roll-off recycling containers are available at each of the three waste sites.

Paper Products - Recyclable

Newspaper, Magazines, Flyers, Catalogues, Household Paper, Cardboard, Boxboard (i.e. cereal boxes), Cardboard egg cartons, Envelopes, Soft cover books, Tetra Packs, Juice Boxes and Milk Cartons

Non-recyclable

Hard cover books (unless cover removed), wax coated cardboard, wax covered boxboard, construction paper, Christmas wrap.

Cans - Recyclable

Aluminum and tin food and beverage containers.

Non-recyclable

Scrap metal (i.e. clothes hangers, cutlery).

Plastics – Recyclable (No.1 P.E.T.) (No.'s 2-7)

No. 1-7 RIGID plastic containers (check for the number on the bottom)

Non-recyclable

Any plastic except those stamped with a number 1-7.

Glass - Recyclable

Clear and coloured glass bottles and jars.

Non-recyclable

Dishes, ceramics, window glass.

Non-recyclable

SM Blue/Pink House Insulation, packing peanuts, Pool noodles (floaties), Styrofoam kids toys.

Plastic Bags

Any plastic bag with a recycling logo including 1 Litre milk bags, bread bags and grocery bags. Bags must be bagged together and placed in the Cans and Plastics bin.

All Dry Cell Batteries

Recyclable at all three waste sites as well as the Township office and many local businesses.

4. All recycling items shall be placed within the applicable compartment of the recycling bin located at the Waste Disposal Site and in compliance with the directions of the Waste Disposal Site Attendant.

5. Recycling guidelines detailing items which may and may not be deposited within the recycling bin shall be available to the public from the Waste Disposal site Attendant and at the Township Office and shall be strictly adhered to.

6. Clean corrugated cardboard free of wax, grease, oil & paint shall be accepted for recycling at the Municipal Waste Disposal site. Cardboard shall be flattened before being deposited within the corrugated cardboard container located at the Municipal Waste Disposal Site & in compliance with the Waste Disposal Site Attendant.

7. Brush for burning shall only be accepted at the Hinchinbrooke Waste Disposal Site in accordance with the provisions of this By-law and in compliance

with the directions of the Waste Disposal Site Attendant.

8. Scrap metal and white goods shall be accepted for recycling at the Municipal Waste Disposal sites in accordance with this By-law.

9. Items containing Freon or any Ozone depleting refrigerant shall be accepted intact free of charge.

10. Scrap metal and white goods shall be placed in the Waste Disposal Site as directed by the Waste Disposal Site Attendant.

11. Tires shall be accepted at the Waste Disposal Sites at no charge in accordance with the provisions of this By-law and in compliance with the directions of the Waste Disposal Site Attendant.

a) All rims must be removed from tires.

b) Tires must be clean before they are dropped off.

c) Tires are to be deposited at the Tire Disposal Area in accordance with the directions of the Attendant.

12. E- Waste shall be accepted at the OSO waste site on Wemp Road and the Olden Waste Site on Olden Park Road at no charge and shall be placed in the bin assigned by the attendant. The items accepted for recycling are determined by the Ontario Electronic Stewardship (OES) and will be changed from time to time.

PROHIBITED WASTE MATERIALS FOR LANDFILLING BUT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

-E-waste, tires, batteries

-Recyclable waste - scrap metal - white metal

- Brush and clean, nail free, untreated lumber, stumps (Only accepted at the Hinchinbrooke Transfer Station)

Composting items are not prohibited at the waste sites but the Township encourages the use of backyard composting bins

AMNESTY LOAD

The Amnesty Load will run from May 9th -May 24th, 2015 and from August 29th -September 13th, 2015.

Each property with an inhabited dwelling is entitled to one load per year with a maximum value of \$40.

Any load larger than \$40 dollars will require payment on the difference as per By-Law #2012-10.
